OLL T-Ball Rules

- The entire team shall take the field.
- Players must bat off a tee.
- There will be no standings or score keeping in the T-Ball League.
- There will be no strikeouts, base stealing or base leading allowed. After the fifth strike the coach may assist the batter.
- Game length should be no more than 60 minutes.
- Managers and/or Coaches should be on the playing field to explain to the players what they are doing wrong and to show them proper procedure or play.
- The entire team roster shall constitute the batting order for each inning. Last batter runs all the bases. Coaches are encouraged to change batting order each game so all players get a chance to bat first and last. An inning is over after both teams have batted their entire roster.
- All players must play at least one (1) inning in the infield per game.
- If a hit ball travels less than five (5) feet from the tee it is a foul ball. Coach's discretion.
- Players advance one base at a time. If a player is called out that player returns to the bench.
- Ball is returned to the catcher after play is stopped.
- Catcher shall wear a helmet and stand near the fence/backstop until ball is in play. Then catcher shall assume a defensive position. Catchers may use a regular playing mitt.
